

CIVIL CASELOAD DEFINITIONS

Regular Actions	Chapter 60 regular civil cases
Contract	If an action is contractual in nature. Included in this category are: buyer plaintiff cases; employment disputes; employment discrimination; fraud; landlord/tenant disputes; landlord/tenant forcible detainers; and debt collection cases.
Tort	All personal injury cases. Included in this category are: product liability cases; slander cases; premises liability cases; and personal injury cases arising from auto accidents; and medical malpractice actions.
Real Property	Involvement of real estate. Included in this category are: eminent domain and mortgage foreclosure cases.
Other	Included in this category are: replevins; tax appeals; actions under KSA 60-1507; habeas corpus actions; workers compensation cases; small claims appeals; injunctions; rights of majority, change of name; and other regular civil actions excluding domestic matters.
Domestic Relations	Domestic relations cases
Marital Status	Includes divorce and annulments.
Parentage Act	Includes cases that establish parent and child relationships and legal responsibility for child support.
Protection from Abuse	Protection from abuse or bodily injury for victims who are or formerly reside together.
Protection from Stalking	Protection from the intentional harassment of another person that places the other person in reasonable fear for that person's safety.
Other	Included in this category are: separate maintenance cases; registration of foreign support orders; and other domestic matters.
Limited Actions	Chapter 61 civil cases. Effective January 1, 2001, limited actions cases are those for the collection of unsecured debts without any limitation on the dollar amount, or, those cases involving claims of \$25,000 or less for other civil actions filed under the Kansas Code of Civil Procedure for Limited Actions.

Real Property	Involvement of real estate.
Other	Replevin suits involving claims of \$25,000 or less.
